IMPORTANT DATES & COSTS

- April 18: The Start Abroad in Barcelona application portal opens on the Barcelona SAE website at 11:00am ET to those on the call today, and 12:00pm ET to the public.
- May 6: Start Abroad in Barcelona applications are due to Barcelona SAE by 5:00pm ET.
- May 8: Students will be notified of acceptance or waitlist to the Start Abroad in Barcelona program.
- **July & August**: Virtual pre-departure sessions exact dates and times TBD.
- **September 16**: Program start date and student arrival in Barcelona.
- **December 13**: Program ends and housing check-out.

The Fall 2024 **Start Abroad in Barcelona**Semester Program cost per student is
\$21,950

- Intended major


